INTRODUCING RESILIENT TAMPA

A Roadmap towards a Stronger and More Equitable Future



We are at a critical moment in our city's history. Tampa is emerging from a year of challenges brought on by the COVID-19 pandemic, extraordinary growth, impacts of a changing climate, and long-standing economic and social inequities. Resilient Tampa is an opportunity to come together, harnessing our collective strengths in order to address these challenges and reach our full potential.

Under the leadership of Mayor Jane Castor, Tampa is now poised to build upon our city's assets and strengths, including our recent economic and population growth, the vibrant diversity across our neighborhoods, as well as collaborative partnerships across government, nonprofits, businesses, and philanthropy. With this as our foundation, we have the opportunity to forge a stronger, more inclusive, and more resilient city.

Resilient Tampa lays out a path forward to achieve this ambition. The Mayor's visionary Transforming Tampa's Tomorrow (T3) strategy, launched in 2019, laid the groundwork for this Roadmap. Building on T3, over the past year, the Resilient Tampa Roadmap was developed through a process that included widespread community engagement as well as a variety of data sources and analytical tools to prioritize the city's most urgent shocks and stresses. These include both inevitable catastrophic events as well as those simmering disasters that affect Tampanians every day.
